Instructions for use



Uncompromising on safety, only high performance materials are used in the manufacture of the Fred range. This Anti-Skid Tape is engineered from top quality PE film.

What's included:

- (A) 1 x 5m Yellow Warning Tape
- (B) 1 x 5m Transparent Tape
- (C) Masking Tape

Recommended Usage

Use transparent tape on slippery surfaces where a child needs protection from potential slips without distraction e.g. on stairs where the child needs to focus on navigating each step and holding onto banisters. Use the yellow warning tape to draw attention to hazards such as concealed steps.



CAUTION! To do its job Fred ToughHold™ adhesive needs to be powerful. This means there is a risk that the tape may cause damage, particularly in high traffic areas or when it has been in place for a long time (residue and damage-free removal of the tape depends on the stair or floor surface). Please be aware that any damage caused is entirely the responsibility of the user.

Step by step installation guide

Fred ToughHold™ adhesive is instantly strong. It cannot be repositioned if done incorrectly. Before removing the protective layer, test each step and ensure the surface is clean, dry and free of grease and dirt.

Use on stairs

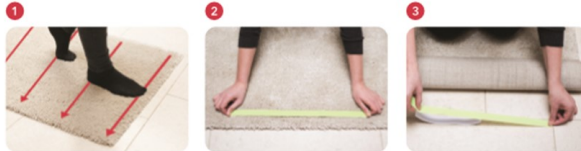


1. Cut the masking tape to the width of your stairs. Position it straight and flush with the edge of your step.

2. Cut the Anti-Skid Tape to the width of your stairs and gradually peel off the backing paper. Stick it lightly into position using the inner edge of the masking tape as a guide.

3. Remove the masking tape and apply firm pressure to the Anti-Skid Tape, rubbing to push out any air pockets underneath.

Use under rugs



1. Strips of tape should be positioned perpendicular to the direction that you most often walk across the rug.

2. Measure the length of Anti-Skid Tape that you need and cut to length.

3. With the rug in your favourite position, roll back the edge 3-4cm to expose the floor underneath. Gradually peel off the backing paper and using the rug as a guide, stick the Anti-Skid Tape firmly into position, pushing out any air pockets that have been trapped underneath.



4. Repeat at 15cm intervals along the length of the rug.

To permanently remove



Use a blunt knife to carefully prise a corner of the Anti-Skid Tape from the surface. Gently pull off the remaining tape, and rub away any residual adhesive with your fingers.
